## **10 MAKEUP TIPS FOR YOUR PROFESSIONAL HEADSHOT**

*L*. Apply your makeup in natural light, this will help ensure you have an attractive and even look.

2. Never apply sunscreen for a photo shoot, as this can "flash back" in photos by giving a white halo under your eyes and on your cheeks.

J. Foundation should always match your neck/chest area, don't forget about your ears. Apply your foundation in light even layers.

Lips should be a natural color that enhances the color of your lips. A bit of lip gloss applied to the center of the lip will make your lips appear fuller.

**O.** Eye makeup should be a beautiful everyday look, using mostly matte neutral or complimentary tones.

**O.** Use black mascara to give your eyes definition – no false eyelashes please.

• Eyebrows are important since they frame the eye. Lightly fill in your eyebrows with an eyebrow pencil.

Slush is a great tool to give your cheeks a rosy, slightly flushed look.

9 Contour your cheekbones lightly to give some definition to your face.

IO. Finish your makeup with a touch of translucent powder to reduce shine.
